George E. Snell

George E. Snell was one of the founders of Kiwanis in Montana with the establishment of the Montana District of Kiwanis International.

He was a member of the Kiwanis Club of Billings, and served as the first Governor of the Montana District, serving in 1921, 1922, and 1923. He was also the "Grandfather" of Key Club in Montana, helping to establish Key Clubs in 1946.

George served as a Kiwanis International Trustee from 1924-1928, and again from 1933-1937. In 1943 he served as the Kiwanis International Vice President.

George E Snell Fellowship

A club or individual who contribute \$500 to the Kiwanis Foundation of Montana may honor or have awarded a George E. Snell Fellowship to a named recipient. The honoree may be a Kiwanis member, community member, business leader, or the donor themselves.
